The reason of this Prospectus?

Personal data is being processed - in the framework of provision of services on the website www.avlzalazone.com and the functions provided there - by AVL-ZalaZONE Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as Company).

Please note that your visit to the website is not subject to registration.

The Company acknowledges the importance of presenting the data subject to the processing of personal data, its most important characteristics and circumstances, which they have come to know in the course of their data processing activities.

The terms used in this prospectus are interpreted in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter referred to as the General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR) Article 4.

Who manages your personal data?

Your personal data is processed by **AVL-ZalaZONE Ltd.** as controller.

The recipients of personal data are also involved in the processing of personal data, the identity of them can be found under the individual data management title "**Who are the recipients of personal data?**".

What principles does the Company see as important for the processing of your personal data?

The Company respects the personal rights of the subjects to the course of its data processing activities, in which it processes their personal data in accordance with the applicable legal environment. In view of this, it guarantees the practice of the General Data Protection Regulation and of the Act No. CXII of 2011 on the Right of Information self-determination and freedom of information, as well as of the sectoral legislation affecting specific processing. The security of the personal data provided is protected by possible and necessary technical means and organisational measures. By doing so, we pay particular attention to the ensuring of confidentiality, integrity and availability of your personal data. The Company is responsible for the accuracy of the personal data after you provided it.

Categories of subjects

In the course of the processing activities resulting from the operation of the website, subjects are the persons who have **established a relationship with the Company**, the **persons included in the recordings posted on the website**, users of a service provided by the Company and all those who **wish to partner with a sponsor or media contact the Company**.

What are your rights in relation to the personal data processed by the Company?

If the Company manages your personal data, you will have the following rights under the GDPR; the time limit for the completion of yours rights (provided that no extension is made) shall not exceed one month after receipt of the application or request:

- ***the right to be informed and access***, whereby the data subject has the right to receive feedback from the controller as to whether his or her personal data is being processed and, if such processing is ongoing, the right to be given access to personal data, as well as to the categories of personal data concerned, the purposes of the processing, the categories of recipients or recipients with whom the personal data have been or will be communicated, where appropriate, for the intended duration of the storage of personal data, and to the categories of personal data concerned, the purposes of the processing, the categories of recipients or recipients with whom the personal data have been or will be communicated, where appropriate, the intended duration of the storage of the personal data, or, if this is not possible, the criteria for determining that period, and the right of the data subject to request the controller to rectify, delete or restrict the

processing of the personal data relating to him and to object to the processing of such personal data. and the right to lodge a complaint addressed to a supervisory authority.

- ***the right to rectification***, the data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, the data subject shall have the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement.

- ***the right to erasure*** under which the The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay and the controller shall have the obligation to erase personal data without undue delay of which the processing was made due to consent.

- ***the right to restriction of data processing***, on the basis of which the data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller restriction of processing where the accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject, for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data; the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead; the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims; the data subject has objected to processing in this case pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject.

- ***the right to object***, on the basis of which the data subject shall have the right to object, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her, if the processing is for the validation of legal interest of the controller or of the third party. The Company shall no longer process the personal data unless he demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

- ***the right to data portability***, under which the data subject shall have the right to receive the personal data concerning him or her, which he or she has provided to a controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided, **if** the processing is based on consent or on explicit consent to the processing of those personal data for one or more specified purposes or on contract; **and** the processing is carried out by automated means.

What remedies do you have in relation to your personal data processed by the Company?

If you feel that the company's managing of your personal data is of prejudice, we recommend that you first contact us with your complaint, which we will always examine and do our best to properly handle. If, despite your complaint, you feel prejudice of the company's managing of your personal data or you do not wish to complain to us, you have the following remedies:

Right to complain to the supervisory authority

Without prejudice to other administrative or judicial remedies, all data subject shall have the right, where the data subject thinks that the Data Controller or his or her affiliate Controller by act or omission, has committed or caused a risk of an infringement of rights, to complain to the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (hereinafter referred to as the Supervisory Authority).

The right to an effective judicial remedy against the controller or processor.

Without prejudice to the remedies available for administrative or non-judicial purposes, including the right to complain to the supervisory authority, all data subjects shall be entitled to effective judicial remedy, if he considers that his rights in relation to the processing of his personal data have been violated.

The trial falls within the jurisdiction of the Regional Court. You may decide to bring the case before the Regional Court of your place of residence or stay.

Who are the recipients of the personal data?

The personal data is being processed by the Company's employees who are obliged to send newsletters on the basis of their employment contractual duties. Such employees are the official data processor providing the hosting services of the website, as well as MailChimp.

How long does it take to process your personal data?

The processing of personal data will last until the withdrawal of your given consent, in any other case until no later than the date of termination of or unsubscribing from the Company's newsletter service.

The source of the personal data processed.

The personal data processed comes directly from the data subject using the newsletter service by giving in the requested data.

For what purpose is personal data processed?

What data is processed?

What is the legal basis for the processing of your personal data?

You may withdraw your consent at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the data processing carried out prior to the withdrawal.

Who are the recipients of personal data?

The personal data processed are accessed as recipients by the employees of the Company who, due to their job, are obliged to maintain contact with customers, as well as the hosting provider in accordance with its data processing activities.

Your personal data without your consent will not be transferred to third parties/natural persons, they will only be provided upon a formal request from an authority or official body upon an appropriate legal basis.

How long does it take to process your personal data?

5 years + 60 days from the date of placing the order. In the case of final contracts, on the basis of which an invoice is issued, 8 years + 60 days from the issuance of the invoice (Article 169 § Paragraph (2) of the Accounting Act).
